Middle Earth Hand-glazed Honeycomb tiles are a modern twist to unglazed hexagonal tiles that were prevalent in the late Roman Empire.

Inspired by the tile making in the southern French town of Salernes, which is famous for making hexagonal tiles (called Tomettes). These beautiful tiles adorn many of the floors of the region's houses.

Middle Earth Tiles have taken the original tomette concept and hand glazed the tiles in our special

Like the Tomettes and following the same centuries old techniques, Middle Earth Honeycomb tiles are shaped by wire cutting and fired at temperatures over 1100 C. before being hand glazed in the Middle Earth tile colour selection.


